Daily — Groups move thru our activity areas inside and outside the LBCA including active group games & sports, community/nature activities, music & media, construction and drama, art & science, games room and life skill programming.

Weekly – 2 larger time activities weekly on Tuesday/Thursdays including off-site activities (PreK camp activities will be onsite and in immediate neighborhood), special guests, extended nature/community items like hike, bike, scooter or skate activities, water activity day, interest activities or club days, Thursday special field trips (\$10)

Monthly – Friday fun lunch (posted dates) or family special events /guests dependent on restrictions

PreK camp (3-5 yrs) under 4 hr 8am -11:30 AM \$125.00/5 day wk (weeks with fewer days due to closures will be prorated) – includes all onsite activities— (less preschool subsidy and less \$75 monthly grant)

School age camp (completed Kinder to grade 6) \$220/5 day wk (weeks with fewer days due to closures will be prorated) – includes all onsite and offsite activities - (less subsidy and less monthly kinder grant)

Planned activities on or offsite start in all programs at <u>9 am - 3:30 pm</u> please arrange drop off and pick up considering those times or ask your camp leader for where you will be able to pick up your child. We will try to accommodate requests to have siblings/friends stay together but we do not move a younger child into an older group. In these instances, please ensure that the older child understands that they will be in the younger group.

Hours of program:

- Camp doors open promptly Monday to Friday at **9 am and close at 3:30 pm**, all hours, trips, special foods and supplies are included in fees. There are no additional before (7 am to 9 am) and after care fees (330 pm to 530 pm).
- Camp runs **July 2 to August 23** and we are closed August 5 for the holiday.
- The Centre respects the personal time of its employees/day camp leaders. **Families picking up late** from after-camp care will incur additional charge of \$1/ minute per child after close of 5:30 pm

Parent comments- anything else you want us to know please message us on the **parent app**. New families remember we will need you to also register online to give us all your family emergency information.

Camp notes: Important

- The Centre aims to provide a **nut-free camp** environment. Please help us by NOT sending nut products! Thank you.
- **First day check in** will require all consent/waivers be completed prior to leaving your child on site. Forms may be done in advance of first camp week and brought in for 1st day and will be available on your documents tab of your parent app. New families you will receive access to your parent app by June 15, 2024. Please be sure to double check your emergency contact, email, and medical consideration information. If your child has any medication, you must complete a medical form prior to it being left or administered on site.
- When picking up your child, you will be asked to **provide photo ID**, no exceptions except for guardians well known by camp leaders.
- All off-site activities will have permission forms to be completed weekly for the walk, bike or bus to the location. If necessary, transportation will be provided by our center bus and driver. Our camp leaders have someone with available first aid kit and training, and a cell phone to communicate with our camp supervisor. If you need to get thru to your child during the day, please call the camp supervisor at the center at 403-532-0868. The Centre reserves the right to change events and/or locations or cancel trips due to weather, health restriction, govt cost control/grant changes or safety or numbers in registration.
- Don't forget to check your **weekly calendar** for on and offsite activities. Camps will be outdoors daily and children may get dirty during camp activities, please wear items that can get dirty and shoes that can be used to play games.
- **Please bring daily** send your child dressed for the weather with an outdoor hat, sneakers no flip flops/crocs, brown bag lunch, change of clothes or towel on days needed, bug spray and sun screen and refillable water bottle.
- **Camp leaders** All camps have 1-2 camp leaders and an assistant. All our camp leaders have current police security clearance and experience in educational settings.
